The program is run over 5 weeks at Pioneer Park, [Macquarie Saints ground] off Balaclava Rd, Marsfield. Dates are Sunday 6 June, 20 June, 27 June, 4 July & 18 July (nothing scheduled for Long Weekend 12.13.14 June or Coasties weekend 9, 10, 11 July) from 0900-1130hrs.

A fee of \$50 per player has been set for this program and is payable by cheque (Ryde Hornsby Baseball League) or cash on the first day of the program (Sunday 6 June, 2010). A further fee may be required for players attending Coasties in July.

Saints would like to see as many Junior players as possible register for this development opportunity, especially those who aspire to representative competition.

2010 Junior Grading — 8 August

Saints will be holding its grading day for junior players in Under 10 to U19 teams on Sunday 8th of August from 2 pm to 4 pm at Pioneer Park, Balaclava Road, Marsfield. All players must be registered before grading. For insurance reasons unregistered players will not be allowed to participate in grading. Online registration will open in mid June. Players selected in RHBL Representative teams do not need to attend grading but will be selected in A Grade teams.
