### **About Our Club**

Macquarie Saints is a family friendly Baseball Club formed in 1993 located at Pioneer Park, Marsfield. We field Junior Baseball teams (from 5 years to 18 years) in the summer Ryde Hawks Baseball League and Senior Baseball teams in the summer and winter Pacific Coast Baseball League. In the 2018-19 Season we had 137 Juniors playing baseball with Macquarie Saints and 6 out of our 13 Junior teams reaching the final series with 2 teams winning their Grand Final. To further support the development of the game, the Club and our players, Macquarie Saints has also developed a "Junior Blues" umpiring program to train and develop junior umpires from the Division 1 Grade players within the Club. The participation of our Junior Blues is outstanding and helps these emerging youth develop and demonstrate their leadership skills. Macquarie Saints was voted RHBL "Club of The Year" in the 2012/13 Season & the 2007/08 Season.
